

Cat socialisers

Role title: Cat socialisers.

Location: Canterbury and District Animal Centre.

Number of vacancies: 10

Main purpose of role: To socialise and groom cats in the Animal Centre, working with other volunteers and staff under the direction of the Animal Centre Manager.

Key activities: To spend time with allocated cats in the outdoor pens, actively playing with the cats and encouraging mobility from the cat. In consultation with other volunteers and staff, encourage the cat to socialise and feel comfortable with other people around. To groom the cats as directed by the Centre. To keep records updated as directed by the Centre. To attend appropriate training courses required for the role.

Period of volunteering: We are looking for volunteers for everyday of the week.

Times and preferred duration of commitment: Minimum of 4 hours a week would be preferred but can be flexible.

Experience/skills/knowledge/personal qualities: No experience required as training will be provided. Someone who has owned or worked with cats would be desirable.

Details of training provided: Ongoing training and support will be provided. Any relevant training courses will be offered to the volunteers to attend.
