

Cattery Assistant Volunteers

Role Title: Cattery Assistant Volunteers.

Location: Canterbury and District Animal Centre.

Number of vacancies: 10

Main purpose of role: To provide care for the cats in the centre under the direction of the Animal Centre Manager and maintain administration procedures that are in place.

Key activities: To prepare and provide food and water for the cats in the cattery following instruction laid down by the Centre Manager. To clean, disinfect and maintain a standard of cleanliness cat pods in the cattery as required. Attend to the socialisation, exercise and coat care/grooming needs of the cats. Follow health and safety procedures as laid down by the Centre and ensure they are observed in all aspects of work. Liaise with colleagues in the Centre and branch staff and voluntary helpers.

Period of volunteering: We are looking for volunteers for everyday of the week.

Times and preferred duration of commitment: Minimum of 4 hours every week is preferred but can be flexible.

Experience/skills/knowledge/personal qualities required: No experience needed as training will be provided although someone who owns or worked with cats would be a bonus.

Details of training provided: Ongoing training and support will be provided. Any relevant training course will be available for volunteers to attend.
