

Maintenance volunteers

Role title: Maintenance volunteers.

Location: Canterbury and District Animal Centre.

No of vacancies: 10

Main purpose of role: To perform basic maintenance of buildings, grounds, equipment and other small jobs at the Animal Centre that may be required from time to time.

Key activities: Routine maintenance such as painting and small amounts of carpentry work. To ensure that gullies, drains etc are kept free of debris and that the grounds are litter free. Small amounts of plumbing-unblocking sinks and waste pipes. To repair animal accommodation to high RSPCA standards. To comply with the requirements of health and safety. To report any faults to the Centre Manager.

Period of volunteering: We are looking for volunteers for everyday of the week.

Times and preferred duration of commitment: A minimum of 4 hours per week is preferred.

Experience/skills/knowledge/personal qualities: Experience in a workplace or domestic home maintenance. Needs to have a genuine interest in DIY.

Details of training provided: Health and safety training will be provided along with full training on all motorised machinery.
